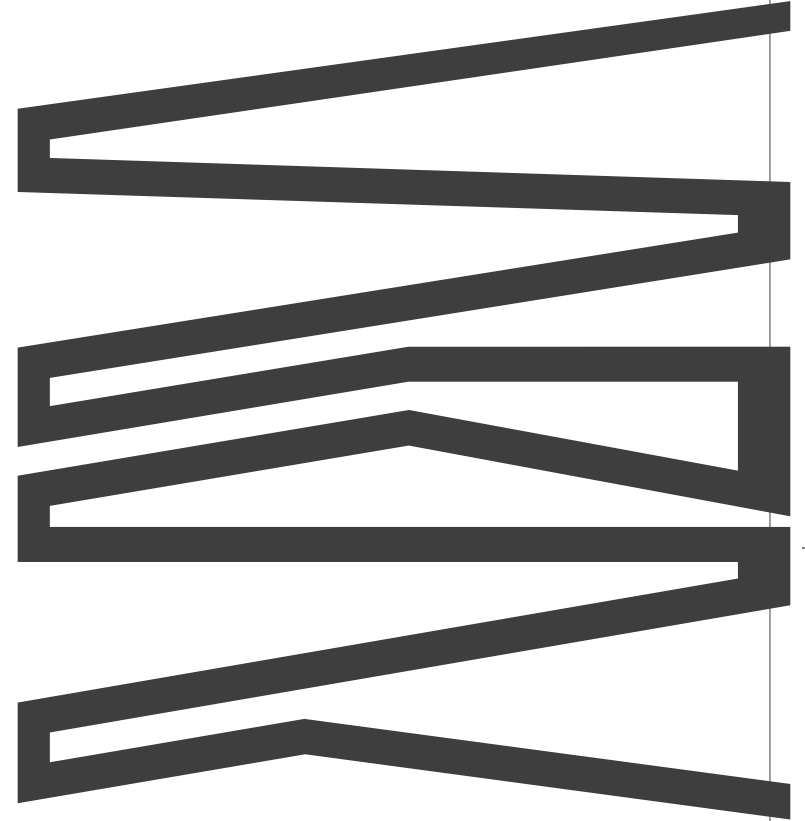
TRAINS Tobu Isesaki Line (Tobu Sky Tree Line): 5-min. walk from Asakusa Sta.

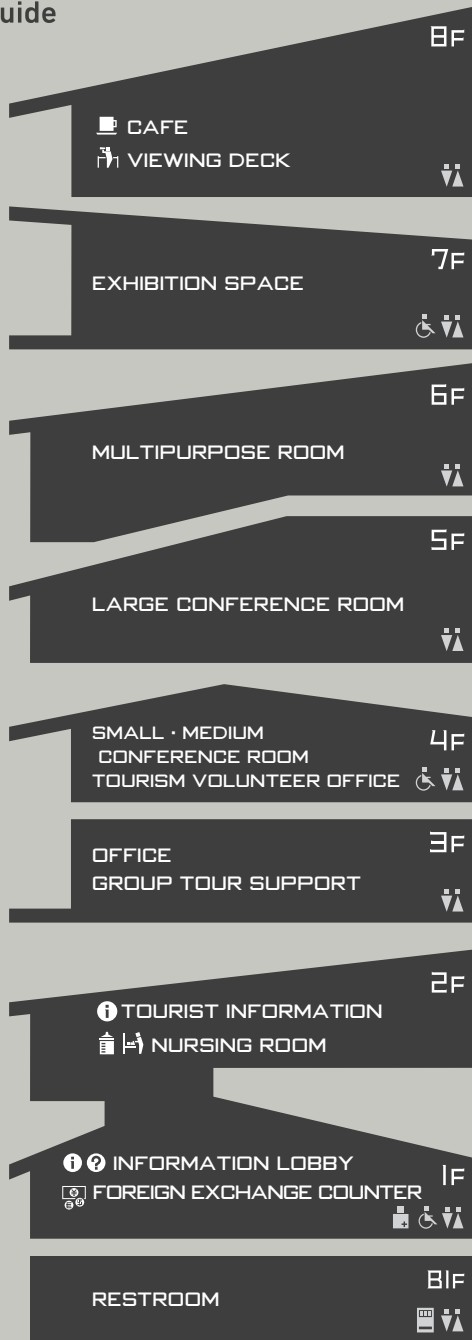

The Asakusa Culture Tourist Information Center is a tourist information facility in Taito City, located in front of the Asakusa Kaminarimon Gate. We provide useful information and services to a great many visitors to Taito City based on the concept of "Finding, Showing and Supporting."


8F VIEWING DECK CAFE

This is a great spot where you can look out over the town of Asakusa and the Tokyo Sky Tree. There is a lookout cafe and space for taking a break while enjoying the view.




7F EXHIBITION SPACE

This space provides information on the highlights, events, history and culture of Taito City. The wooden diorama enables you to know the surroundings of Taito City.



6F MULTIPURPOSE ROOM

This split-level floor showcases images of Taito City. Together with the exhibition space on the 7th floor, the attractions of the city are put on display.

1F INFORMATION LOBBY FOREIGN EXCHANGE

In addition to providing tourist information in four languages (Japanese, English, Chinese, and Korean), we also sell theater and museum tickets. You can come by various free maps and brochures. There is also a foreign currency exchange counter.
