

# Taito City Afterschool Children's Classrooms

—A Safe and Secure Place for All Children—

Afterschool children's classrooms are designed for use by all children, allowing them to stay at school after classes and use facilities such as the schoolyard and gymnasium. It provides a safe and secure place where they can engage in learning, sports, and various experiences and exchange activities.

The program is also held during long holidays, such as summer vacation, starting at 8 a.m., allowing children to bring their own packed lunch and spend the whole day at school.

The operation of the Afterschool Children's Classroom program is outsourced by Taito City and as of April 2026, it is currently conducted at seventenn schools within the city (Ueno Elementary School, Heisei Elementary School, Negishi Elementary School, Tosen Elementary School, Shinobugaoka Elementary School, Yanaka Elementary School, Kuromon Elementary School, Taisho Elementary School, Asakusa Elementary School, Taito Ikuei Elementary School, Kuramae Elementary School, Higashi-Asakusa Elementary School, Fuji Elementary School, Matsuba Elementary School, Senzoku Elementary School, Ishihama Elementary School, and Kinryu Elementary School). It has been decided that an after-school children's classroom will start at Kanasogi Elementary School in April 2027.

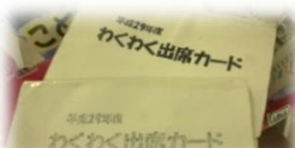
## ☆ Held inside the school

By utilizing school facilities during after-school hours, children can minimize travel and spend their time safely.



## ☆ Flexible participation days

You can choose the days your child participates, taking into account your family's circumstances, such as cram school days or extracurricular activities.



## ☆ Interaction with different grades

Through programs involving mixed-grade activities, children can enhance their communication skills.



## ☆ Safe and secure

Instructors provide supervision to ensure that children can spend their time safely and securely.



## ☆ Physical activity programs

Activities such as soccer and beach ball are offered to promote physical fitness and maintain health.



## ☆ Learning programs

Learning programs turns children's intellectual curiosity and sense of wonder into opportunities for learning.



Note: Program content may vary depending on the school.

## 1 Eligibility and Registration (A typical example)

- All students in grades 1 through 6 attending the schools where the program is implemented are eligible.
- A Usage Guide and Participation Application Form will be distributed in February. (New first-grade students will receive these materials during the enrollment orientation.)
- Advance applications will be accepted from February to March, but **applications can also be submitted after the program starts.**
- An application form and **an insurance fee of 800 yen (annual)** are required at the time of application. There is no usage fee.
- A "Participation Card" will be issued after you apply. This card is required when using the program.

### **Regarding the use of the program by children requiring special consideration**

The Afterschool Children's Classroom program is designed for all children. For children requiring special consideration in group activities, we may need to discuss suitable usage methods. Thank you for your understanding.

## 2 Program Details (A typical example)

### Program Days

Monday to Friday

(excluding Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays, year-end and New Year holidays, school closure periods (mid-August), substitute holidays, and before school lunches begin in April.)

### Hours

On school days: After school to 4:45 p.m or 6:00 p.m.

During long holidays: 8:00 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. or 6:00 p.m.

Notes: 1. Packed lunch is required for all-day use. Snacks are not provided.

2. Program days and hours may vary depending on the school.

3. Monthly newsletters with information on the following month's program, etc., will be distributed.
